Child Protection Policies

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Background checks are not enough. It's important to have a policy that includes an application, background checks, reference checks, and then enforce it in order to prevent abuse.

The first step in putting together a child protection policy is to put together a team of people to help oversee the process. This team should be small enough to work quickly and efficiently but also large enough to distribute the workload. This workload includes both the creation of the policy but also the implementation.
