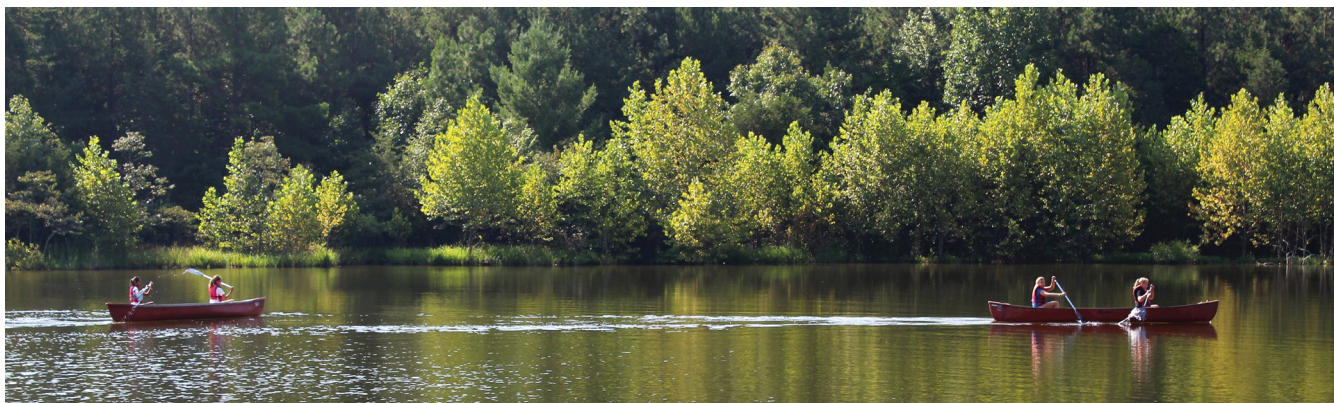

COVID-19 UPDATE

How is Caroline Furnace being affected by COVID-19?

We'll get through this together! Thank you for any support you are able to provide during this time. To put it simply, donor support is what will get us through this outbreak and the related shutdowns. Typical revenue from rentals for the second quarter is at zero, fall and winter deposits will help but cannot sustain us on their own, and all Summer Camp revenue is being held in an account separate from our operating budget. We are operating on a reduced budget with adjusted variable expenses.

What is happening with Summer Camp?

We remain hopeful that Summer Camp is possible this year, but even so, group sizes are limited and expenses will be higher than revenue. No matter what, we are committed to hiring our full Summer Staff and investing in their faith and leadership development. Until we are able to begin Summer Camp on-site, we are offering Camp at Home (virtual camp) for free, open to anyone.
